Vessel Entry Requirements November 2015

The following list represents and provides general requirements for arriving vessels by three agencies: Customs & Quarantine Agency (CQA), U.S. Customs & Border Patrol (USCBP) and the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG).

CQA requirements for entry include:

1. Last Port Clearance
2. Passenger/Crew List
3. Customs Declaration Form
4. Cargo Manifest (when applicable)

USCBP requirements for entry include:

1. Passport
2. B1/B2 Visa (when applicable)
3. Vessel Registration
4. Crew List Manifest (Form I-418)

USCG requirements for entry include:

1. Wearable Personal Floatation Device (PFD): 1 type I, II, III, or V per person
2. Sound signaling appliance or device.
3. Fire extinguisher: 1 B1 is required when of close construction. If vessel is > 26ft. B1 or B2 is required.
4. Visual distress signal: Only required between sunset and when in use on coastal waters and on waters beyond the territorial seas
5. Throwable PFDs: 1 type IV for vessels > 16ft. Not required if vessel < 16ft.
